Welcome back everyone, and a warm welcome to all our new parents, students and staff members. I hope you all had a wonderful summer, and are ready to begin classes on the 15<sup>th</sup> of September. We will be introducing a few changes this academic year so please have a read through to see what's different!

### First Day

On the first day back things usually get a little hectic, students should arrive to School 15 minutes before their scheduled lesson time, and meet in the main hall (except Saturday morning classes which will meet in the large playground). Teachers will collect them from the hall and bring them to their classrooms. All teachers will be holding up a sign with their class name (Foundation 1, Year 3, Nursery etc.). We ask for children to please form a line in front of their teacher.

### Books

Some classes will need new books, while others will be continuing from the books in their previous year. If your children do need new books these can be purchased on the first day of School. They can be picked up 20 minutes after classes begin - This will allow our administrators the chance to help parents with trial classes and queries, before handling book sales.

### Class times

The majority of our class times will stay the same this year, however one notable difference will be the Sunday afternoon lessons. This year Sunday afternoon classes will take place from 1:30pm – 3:20pm.

### Break time

Our Mandarin classes have a five minute break in the middle of the lesson where children can pop out for a drink of water and a small snack. Please pack only a snack box as students will not have enough time to finish a full meal. We ask that parents please ensure that all snacks are nut free as we have a few children with allergies on campus.
